

DESCRIPTION

The Hastings Museum of Natural and Cultural History has started a major collections upgrade project and needs an intern to help with the process. This position will work directly with the collections and the Museum Registrar. This is definitely a hands-on learning opportunity!

Under the direct supervision of the Curator of Collections some of the responsibilities include:

- Enter data into PastPerfect.
- Organize and rehouse artifacts.
- Photograph artifacts and conduct inventory of collection
- Maintain records and reports relating to departmental activities.
- Maintain equipment, materials and supply inventories needed for projects.
- Support different departments within the Museum as needed.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Individual must be enrolled in an accredited college or university and be currently working toward a degree related to the internship.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing and be able to deal with conflict resolution as well as customer service.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher in his/her major and an overall GPA of 2.3 GPA at the time of application.
- Must be a team player, demonstrate responsibility and trustworthiness, and a desire to work in a museum.
